

ASSESSMENT FOR CULP ADVANCED Michaelmas/Lent

Advanced:

- Essay written during the Christmas vacation and submitted via Moodle 10%
- 'Live' Oral presentation with questions asked by class and teacher (Recorded for quality assurance purposes) 30%
- Examination comprising 3 Sections, namely listening comprehension, reading comprehension and essay (Moodle) 50%
- Attendance 5%
- Participation in class 5%

NB: Students are required to achieve at least 45% in the Oral presentation, and in each Section of the Examination, and 50% overall in the assessments, and to have at least 80% attendance in order to pass the course.

The Advanced Examination for all languages offered at this level will take place in person on either first THURSDAY or FRIDAY after the end of the course.

Your teacher will tell you the date and time allocated for your language at the beginning of your course. The date and time are not negotiable. Please make a note of these, so that you do not double-book yourself.
