

## Intermediate Chinese Language Program

---

There are two ways of installing the Intermediate Chinese program:

1. on a webserver, either running on an external server or on your local computer
2. in a directory on your local computer

### 1. Downloading to a webserver

Download the zipped file (intchinese.zip) into a new directory in the webserver's file space. Unzip the file. Make sure the web server process has 'read' permission on all the directories and files of the program. Point a web browser at the index.html file in the root directory to start using the program. Make sure you have Flash Player installed on your computer to access the sound and interactive files in the program.

### 2. Downloading to your own computer

Download the zipped file (intchinese.zip) into a new directory. Make sure Flash Player is installed on your computer. You can download the latest version from:

NB: If you run the program from your own computer (without using a webserver) you will need to set the Global Security Settings for your Flash Player.

In the global Security settings panel, locate the '**Always trust**' files in the locations drop down, select '**Edit locations**', and choose '**Add locations**'.

In the prompt choose the '**Browse for folder**' button and navigate to the location where you have installed Intermediate Chinese.

Load the index.html in the top directory into your web browser to start the program.
